"Sowing the Seeds of Peace" (Zechariah 8:12)

We've all witnessed it, haven't we?

Flowers miraculously blooming across a ravaged landscape. Children holding hands and smiling in the face of war.

We've all seen it and wonder how it's possible. Such scenarios seem unlikely when we've all but given up hope.

And yet ...

The prophet Zechariah casts a vision for peace. He shows forth a world where each person — old and young, all genders and races, people from north, south, east and west — lives without enmity, fear and destruction. In Zechariah's vision, there is "a sowing of peace" where the world is restored, made whole and abides in peace. 
