The special offering for Peace and Global Witness on Noisy Sunday collected over \$700.00. Some of the money will go to the Presbyterian Disaster Witness Program in the wake of all the destruction brought by hurricane Helene.

As part of our Global Witness, the children will be choosing out of the Presbytery Giving Catalog to decide where the rest of the money will go. Some of the choices offered are:

<u>Emergency Life Pack</u> — Supports churches in border regions with backpacks of vital necessities for refugees and asylum seekers as they await the next steps in their process.

<u>Famine Relief Food Voucher</u>—During times of famine and extreme hunger these vouchers can be redeemed with local vendors, helping to nourish the population and strengthen the area's food system.

<u>Refugee Food Basket</u>—Like The Good Samaritan this program extends a caring hand with a basket of food and essential supplies to those around the world who are struggling and searching for a peaceful place to call home.

<u>Jerry Cans</u>— UNICEF estimates women and girls around the world spend 200 million hours every day fetching water. A gift of \$25 provides up to 10 jerry cans to transport water more efficiently.

Plus, there are several programs providing animals (goats, cows, piglets, chickens) to help families around the world. These are just a few of the programs offered in the catalog for the children to choose from.

God of mercy and compassion, we remember all those around the world who face dire living circumstances each day.

Be with them and allow our gifts to strengthen and support them in all ways, so that they may live in safety and security. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.


